**OPPORTUNITY:** This position is responsible to respond to fire and emergency related calls and to maintain job skills through training to ensure overall customer service. In addition, provide medical consultation to staff on emergency site.

**JOB QUALIFICATIONS:** EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE AND/OR TRAINING: At least 21 years of age at the time of application. Graduation from a U.S. high school, G.E.D. or equivalent from a U.S. institution, or a California High School Proficiency Examination (CHSPE) certificate is required. One (1) year of firefighting experience (I.E. volunteer, paid-call, reserve or seasonal). WORK-RELATED KNOWLEDGE: Working knowledge of firefighting equipment and technical specifications; working knowledge of applicable laws, internal controls and policies and procedures of the Fire Department; Ability to conduct or assist in the extrication of trapped persons; Ability to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation; Ability to administer medications by accepted means; Working knowledge of San Diego County Emergency Medical System (EMS) regulations, protocols and procedures; Ability to react quickly and calmly to fight fires and perform emergency medical techniques and procedures.

**LICENSES OR CERTIFICATIONS:** EMT-B, CPR, CSFM F/F I, Defibrillator/Combitube, Haz-Mat FRO, Pack test 45 lb. 3 mi. 45 min., CPAT Certification and Valid Class C driver's license.

### JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assess extent of injuries or illness of trauma victims, patients with respiratory disease and stress, overdose and poisoning victims, industrial accident victims and other ill or injured individuals to determine emergency medical treatment.
2. Administer pre-hospital emergency care, such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), oxygen, bandaging and splinting to patients.
3. Administers medications by intravenous, intramuscular, intranasal, endotracheal tube or topical means.
4. Establish and maintain intravenous treatment (IV), apply adjunctive equipment for ventilation and circulation complications, administer medications and provide other emergency treatment to patients.
5. Utilize basic and advanced airway adjuncts including Endotracheal Intubation of pediatric and adult patients.
6. Utilize cardiac monitor/defibrillator for synchronized cardioversion, external cardiac pacing and defibrillation.
7. Document and record nature of injuries and treatment provided.
8. Be able to read and interpret capnography wave for CO<sub>2</sub>.
9. Perform patient care documentation in accordance with accepted medical practices, department and San Diego EMS standards.
10. Maintain Continuing Education requirements per California Title 22 and maintain Paramedic licensure every two years with required certifications.
