## RESOLUTION NO. 2004-29

### Rincon, San Luiseño Band of Mission Indians

#### A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE RINCON TRIBAL BAR, ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

**WHEREAS**, the Rincon, San Luiseño Band of Mission Indians ("Tribe") is organized pursuant to the Articles of Association passed and approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs on March 15, 1960; and


**WHEREAS**, the Rincon Tribal Council is the duly elected governing body of the Rincon Band, empowered pursuant to the Articles of Association to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribe desires to promote and foster economic development, tribal self-sufficiency and strong tribal government;


**WHEREAS**, the Rincon Tribal Council recognizes that as a result of the economic development and the strengthening of tribal government, there will increasingly be persons representing other persons before the Rincon Tribal Council, tribal commissions and political subdivisions and in order to make sure that those representatives are sufficiently qualified and of good moral character; and


**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the Rincon Tribal Bar, admission requirements to the Bar, and procedures for application for admission are established as set forth in the Rincon Tribal Ordinance Regarding Admission to Rincon Tribal Bar.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution shall be effective on December 2, 2004.





**RINCON SAN LUISEÑO BAND OF MISSION INDIANS  
TRIBAL ORDINANCE RE ADMISSION TO RINCON TRIBAL BAR**

**Section A**     **Representation Requirements.** Any member of a federally recognized tribe who is selected to represent a Rincon tribal member or any attorney representing any person or entity before the Rincon Tribal Council or any other tribal commission or subdivision must be a licensed member of the Rincon Tribal Bar.

**Section B**     **Eligibility for Admission.** The following classes of persons are eligible for admission to the Tribal Bar if otherwise qualified:

- (1) Enrolled members of the Rincon Tribe;
- (2) A member of a federally recognized tribe resident or domiciled on the Rincon reservation ; and
- (3) Licensed members in good standing of any other tribal or state bar association.


**Section C**     **Procedure for Admission.** To be admitted to the Rincon Tribal Bar, an eligible person must:

- (1) file an application for admission with the Rincon Tribal council certifying that he or she:
  - a. satisfies at least one of the eligibility criteria set forth in subsection (B); and
  - b. is of good moral character;
- (2) be approved by the Tribal Council; and
- (3) pay the Tribal Bar admission fee.


**Section D**     **Approval by Tribal Council.** Upon receipt of an application for admission to the Tribal Bar, the Rincon Tribal Council shall review the application and may investigate into the truth of the matters contained herein. If satisfied that the applicant meets the qualifications set forth herein, the Tribal Council shall notify such person who may then gain admission by paying the required fee.


**Section E**     **Admission Fees.** The annual admission fee for membership in the Rincon Tribal Bar is Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). The fee, or part of it, may be waived for good cause shown.


**Section G**     **Attorney's Fees.** Attorneys practicing before the Rincon Tribal Council or other Tribal Commission or subdivision may charge reasonable fees.




